This agreement is between the Technik Football and the player identified in the registration segment of this document. It is a statement of intent and expectations.

Technik Football will:

Provide an environment to develop the player with emphasis on technique creativity and skill.

The player development program exists to promote excellence in football and provide the best opportunity for players to reach their full potential in the game.

Technik Football is committed to providing the best Coaches possible for players. Coaches that have achieved a high level of competence through playing experience and/or practical and theoretical training are to be engaged.

Technik Football staff understand that there is life outside of football and that players have other commitments such as family, education and other sporting and personal interests. The Academy will not penalise players who have genuine commitments which sometimes clash with their football program activities.

Technik Football staff will place player safety above all other considerations and promote a safe and injury free playing and training environment.
Acknowledge and appreciate the physical and emotional developmental needs of players

The player development program recognises that as players grow in the game and in life, additional pressures may be placed on them. Technik Football staff are aware that physical and emotional changes will occur at different stages of a player's development.

Technik Football has its own player development method but in line with the FFA curriculum. We will rejoice in individual skills as well as excellent team performances. Provide an equal opportunity for all players to participate in games and activities without favouritism.

All players in the program will be treated equally as individuals. While it is acknowledged that some players will develop before others and that skill levels may vary, an equal opportunity to play and participate will be afforded each player.

As a player in the Technik Football player development program , you will:

Read and abide by the Technik Football Code of Conduct

Be punctual and committed to the program

Monitor and be responsible for your own health and advise your squad Coach of any injuries and illnesses that you suffer

Participate player development activities, including training and games, to the best of your ability .

Wear your Technik Football uniform at all sessions.

Player code of conduct

- in games accept defeat with dignity and don't seek excuses for defeat or blame the referee or anyone else.
- Treat all participants equally, and reject corruption, drugs, racism, violence and other dangers to our sport.
- Help others to resist corrupting pressures and remind them of their commitment to their team and the game.
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates and opponents.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants, coaches and officials.
- Denounce those who attempt to discredit our sport.
- Honour those who defend football's good reputation with honesty and fairness and encourage others to act in the same way.

- Your child is a player of the Technik Football player development program. Your conduct reflects the reputation of Technik Football.
- The children play football for their enjoyment , not yours.
- Do not force children to participate , encourage and always be positive
- Focus on the childs effort and performance rather than winning
- Encourage always to play by the rules.
- Never yell or shout at your childs error always be constructive
- Applaud good plays by players and teams, that is a good example
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities
- Respect officials decisions and teach children to do likewise
- Show appreciation to all coaches and staff of the player development program
